Leadership	15	This session will provide an overview of leadership in the NHS, with a focus on collective leadership and the skills required to be an effective leader in the NHS.
Health Promotion - Making Every Contact Count	15	Understanding Making Every Contact Count (MECC), looking at health-related behaviour change including readiness to change
Quality Improvement	15	This session will increase awareness of QI activity and tools, demonstrate the application of QI tools and recognise the link between QI and patient outcomes and the individual's roles and responsibilities for creating a QI culture.
Optional Modules	CPD Points	Description
CBT AHPs	15	Introduction into the clinical model for CBT, formulation of clinical picture (feelings, emotions, thoughts, actions), introduction on Socratic questioning with some role play. Outcome - an awareness how CBT can support AHPs in every day clinical work
Enabling Inpatients: Rehabilitation approach for Nurses	15	This course is for nursing staff to develop their knowledge and understanding and application of safe rehabilitation to: maximise patient independence, maintaining patient safety whilst optimising function
Essential Critical Care Skills	5	This webinar will provide staff with the theoretical knowledge to care for patients who are critically ill,
Forensic Radiography	10	This webinar will introduce radiographers to the latest guidance and legislation in Forensic Radiography. Participants will explore forensic radiography guidelines and how these apply in the practice setting.
Frailty	10	This masterclass provides an overview of the care needs of frail older adults for a multidisciplinary group. Through facilitative sessions you help to shape the masterclass content and identify learning aims as a group.
Human Factors	5	Introduction to human factors within health care.
Image Interpretation	15	The webinar will update staff in image interpretation and the red dot system. Participants will build on existing anatomical and diagnostic knowledge to enable accurate interpretation of radiographic findings
Interpretation of Blood Results	15	This masterclass will provide an overview of common blood tests used in practice with a brief discussion around the nature of the test and some potential reasons for common variations of results. A common reference range for blood results will be presented. This is aimed to give a better understanding of the common blood tests used in practice. However due to the numerous blood tests available not all will be covered so this masterclass will consider only those most frequently used in practice and discuss in relation to these.
Intro to ITU and Care of the Ventilated Patient	5	You are introduced to the concepts of managing and caring for a ventilated patient within a critical care environment.
Neurological Rehabilitation for AHPs	15	This course is suitable for AHP staff who are not neurological specialists. It will explore: the pathology of a range of common conditions, examine the cognitive and physical manifestations of the disease process, and discuss patient risk assessment in relation to an individual's function and independence
Paediatric Clinical Skills	10	This masterclass aims to equip you with updated information, current evidence-based practice and guidance regarding paediatric catheterisation, tracheostomy insertion and care, nasogastric and NJ tubes, CVAD and immunisations
